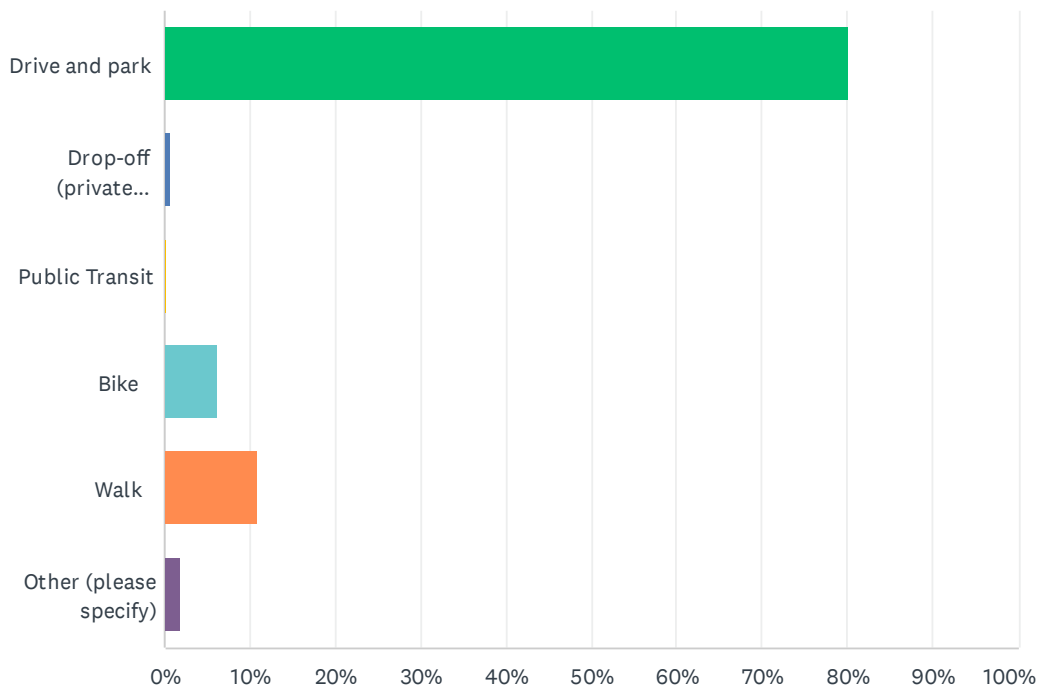


Q1 What do you anticipate will be your primary mode of transportation to the site? (Select one)

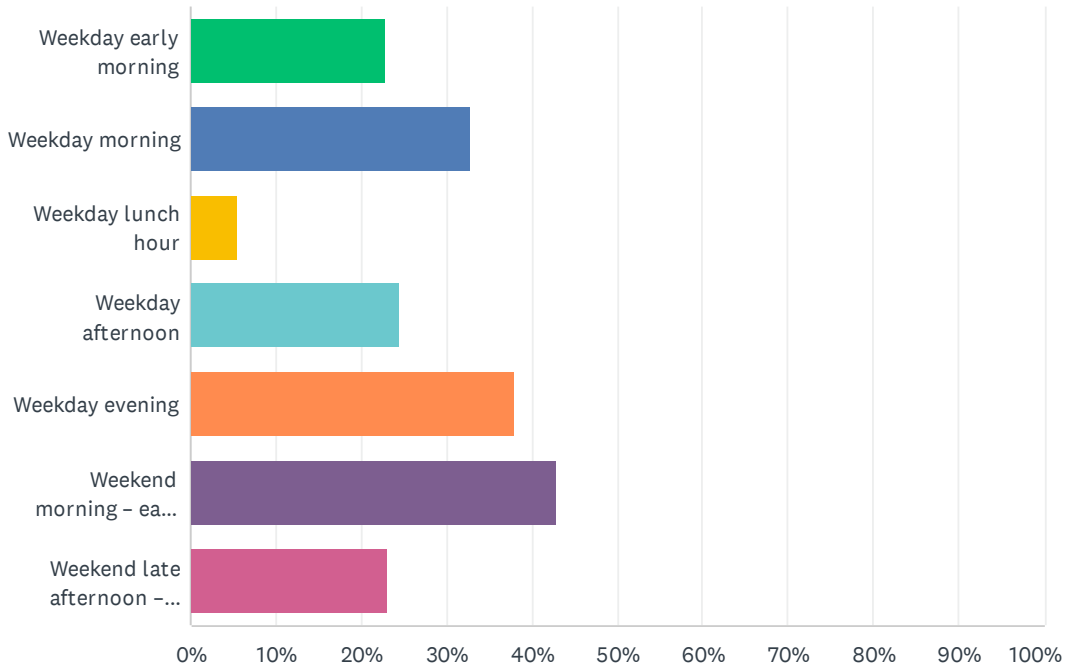

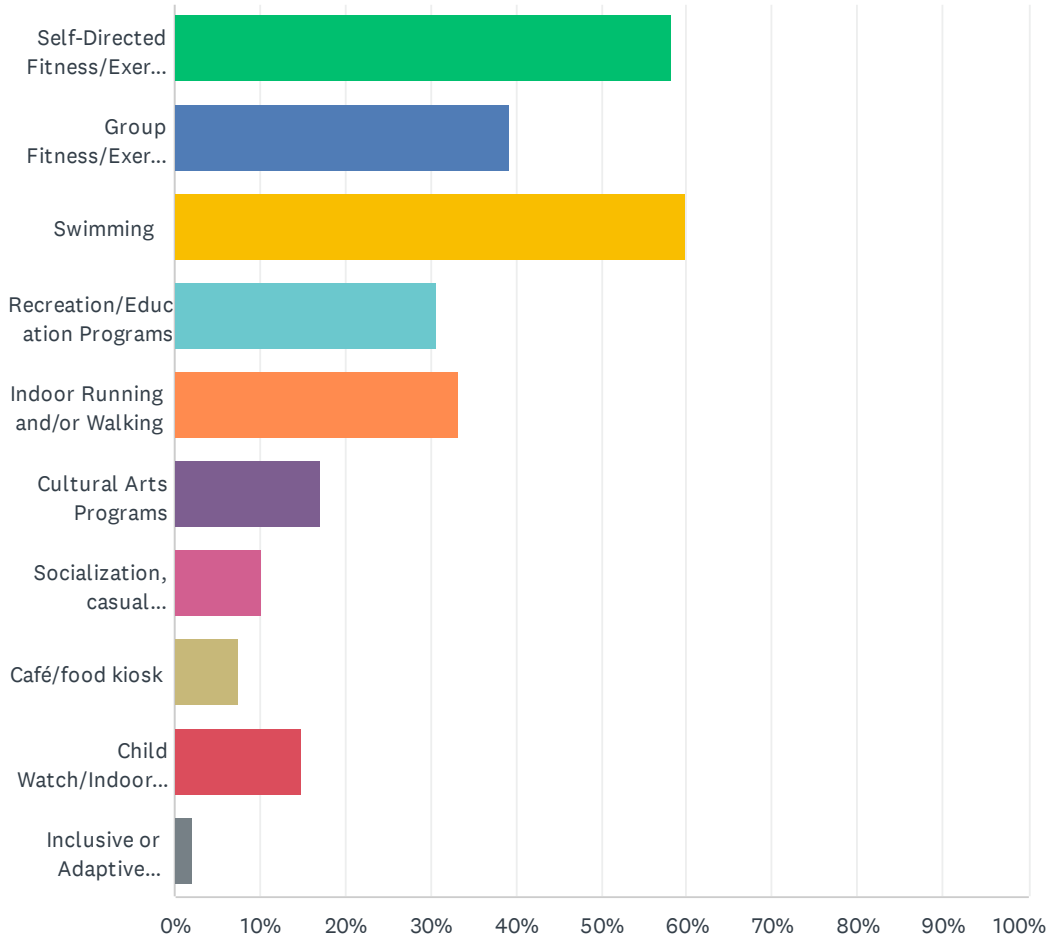

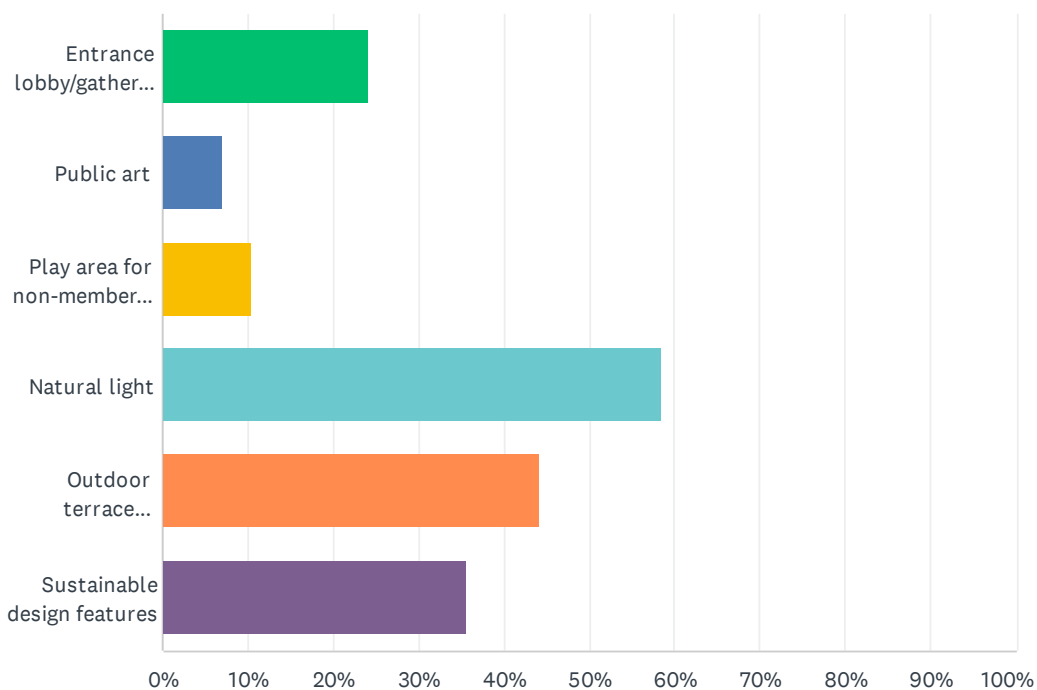

Q4 What design features are most important to you? (Select up to two)

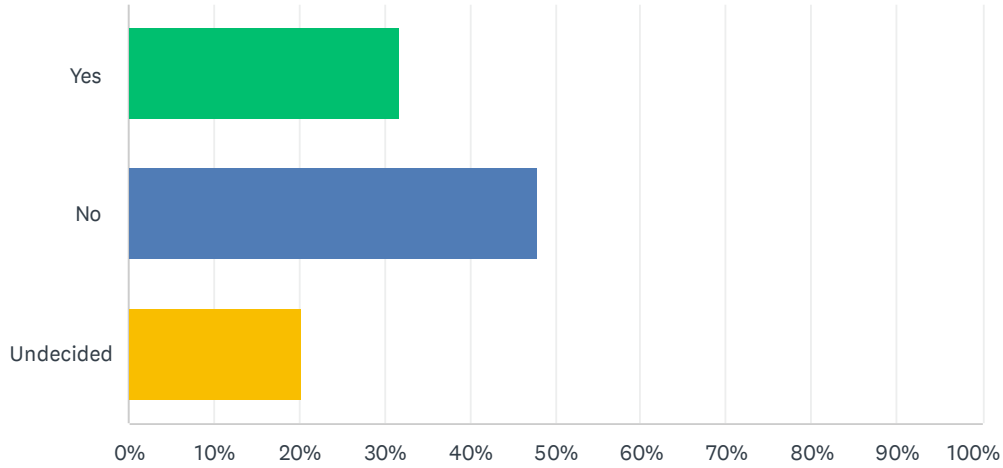

Q5 The UACC will include a senior social lounge space accessible to all older adult members of the UACC. Do you have interest in using the senior lounge?

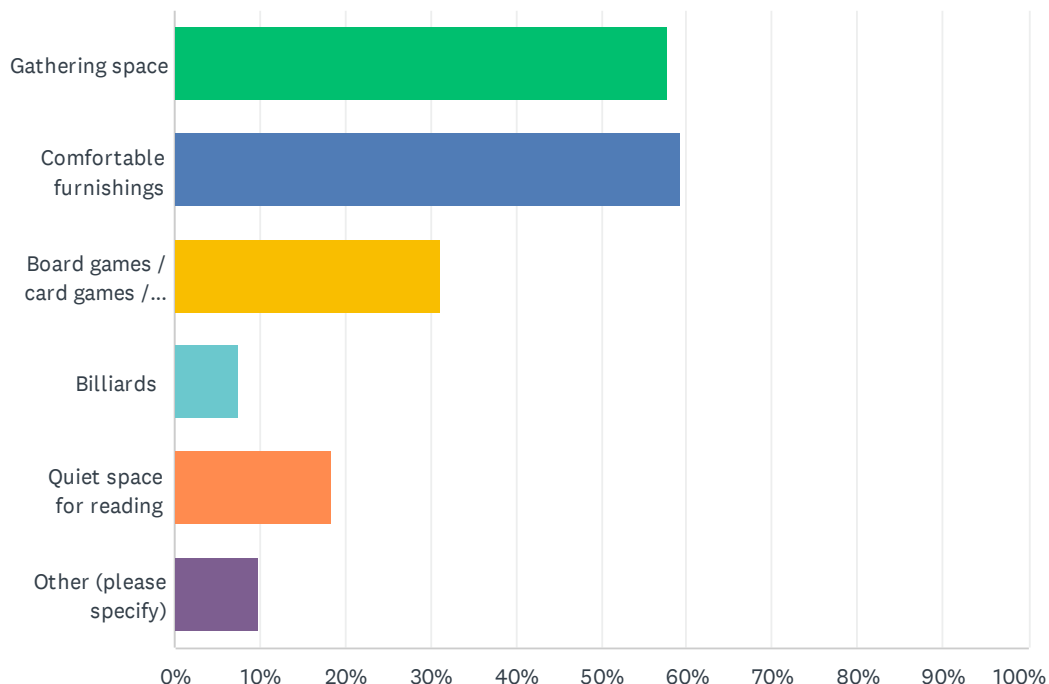

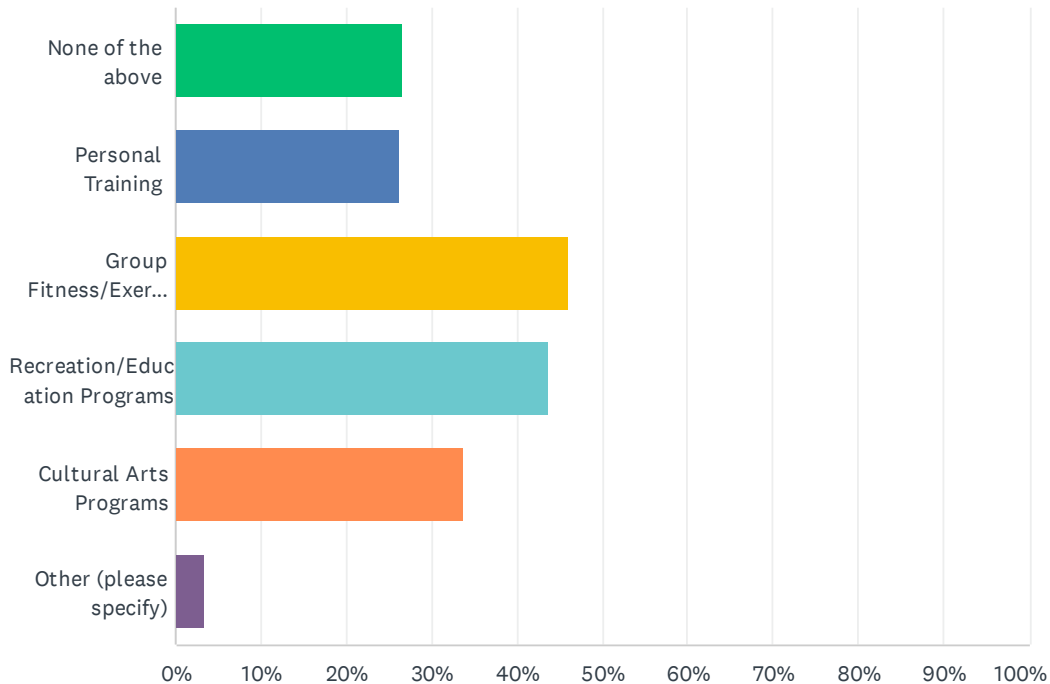

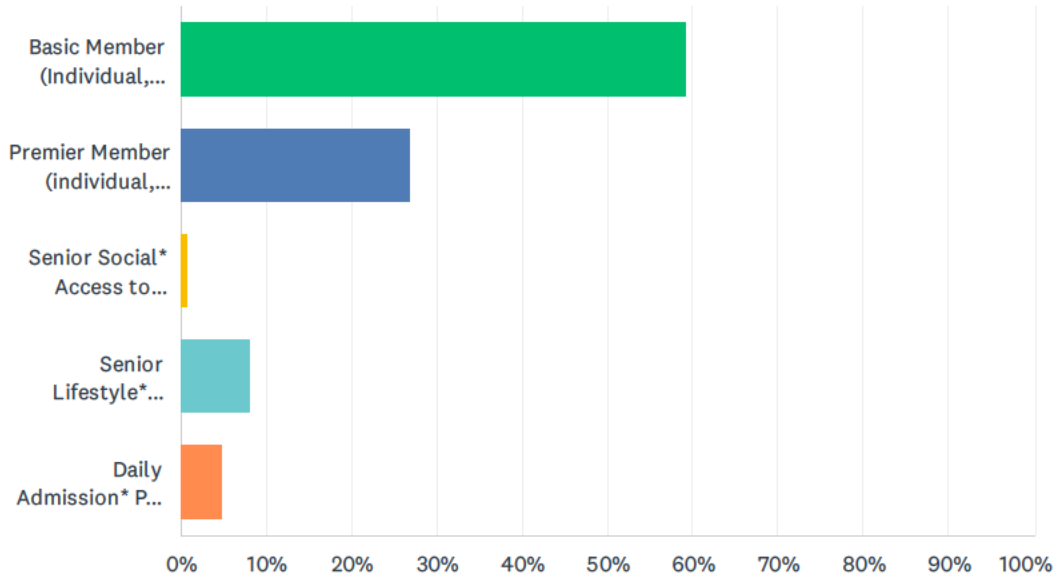

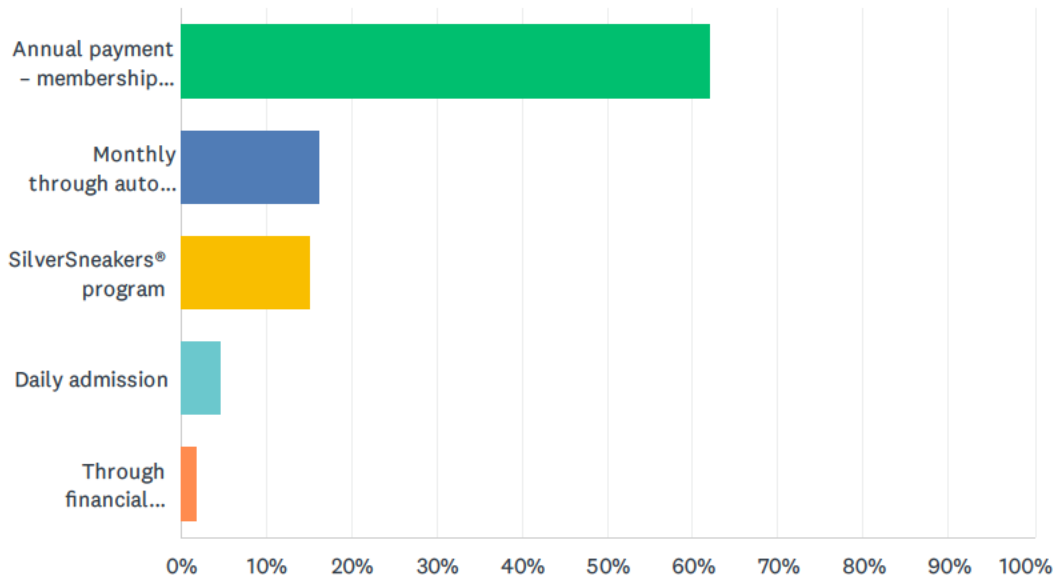

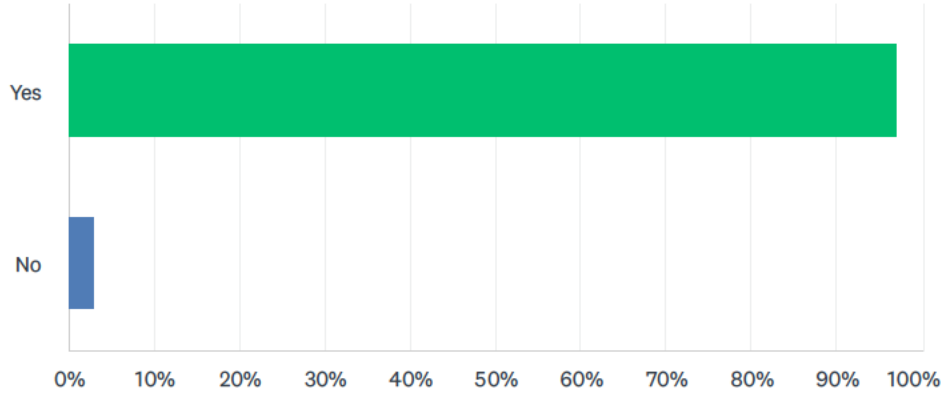

Q14 Are you a resident (live or work) of Upper Arlington or do you plan to be by Fall of 2024?

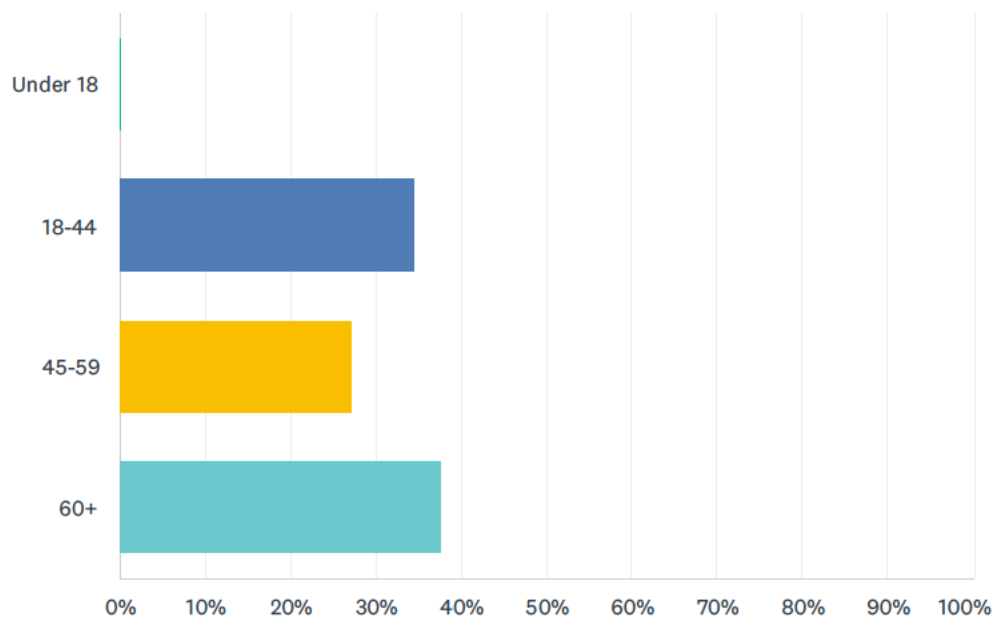

Q15 Please indicate your age range

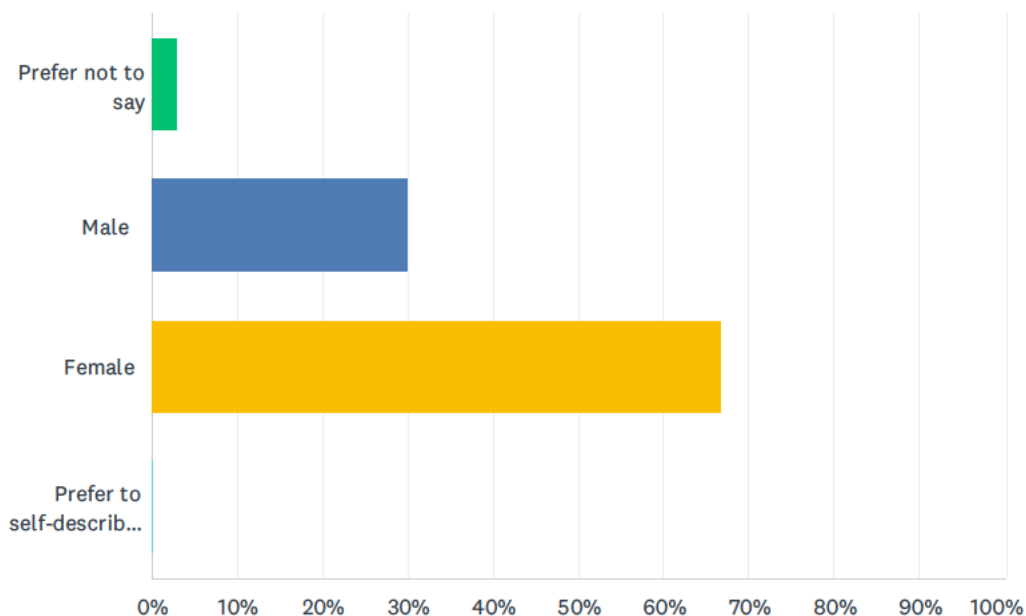

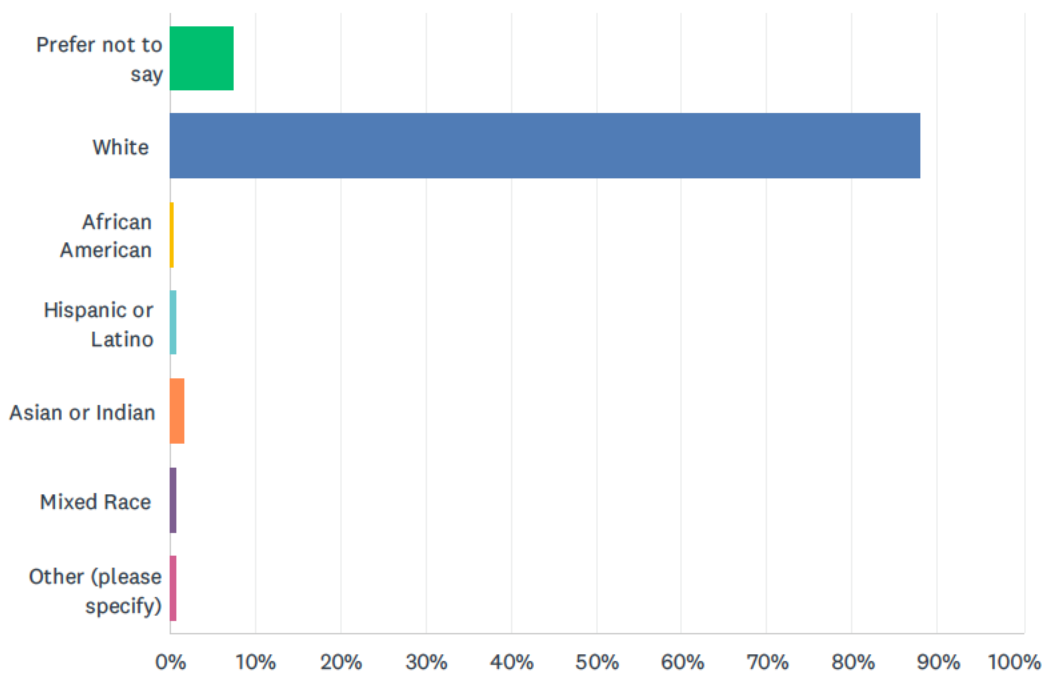

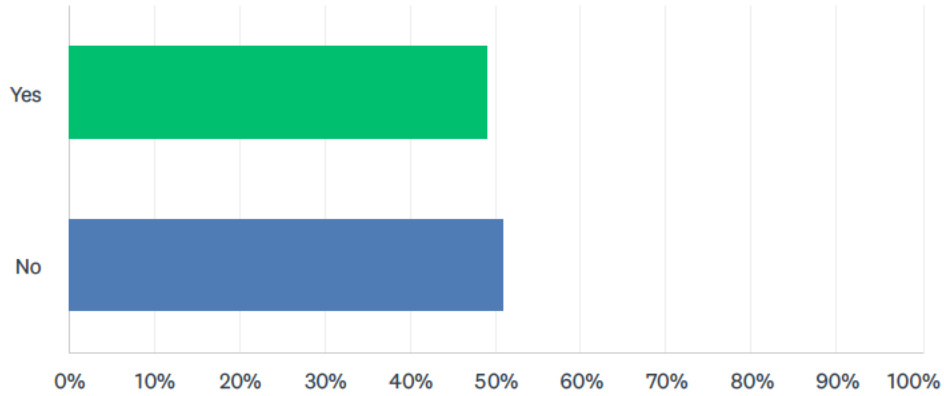
