

Senior Center Parking Lot Update

You may have noticed that when the parking lot was resurfaced that there is a new traffic pattern, one entrance and one exit only. When you enter the parking lot you will no longer be able to turn right, you must proceed straight to have a one-way continued clockwise route. To leave the parking lot you may no longer go out the entrance and must only use the exit.

When backing out of your parking space, be sure that it permits you to continue the clockwise route so the parking lot is a one-way pattern as well. Please review the provided parking lot map for the traffic pattern.
