UA Real Property Tax Abatement Program

- Another name for the CRA and Enterprise Zone Program
- Provides for enhanced abatements for up to 100 percent for up to 15 years for projects within targeted office sectors that meet certain job, wage and investment requirements, as well as increase City tax revenues

UA Job Creation Grant or Refundable Credit

- Provide reimbursement of payroll withholdings paid for a certain number of years tied to jobs (new or retained), wages and investment requirements, as well as increased City tax revenues
- Set up to be performance-based with clawback provisions

UA Infrastructure Fund

 Will provide road, utility and other public improvements using TIF or other revenues for certain highimpact projects



Action Item: Understand and evaluate competitiveness of existing incentives (contd.)

UA Sustainable Building Incentive

 Provides an extended property tax abatement and/or potentially discounted building permit fees for developers that meet LEED or other sustainable building requirements to encourage more sustainable construction in UA

Land Acquisition

Continue to offer for certain high-impact projects

Corridor Enhancement Program

- Provides grants or no-cost financing to building owners and commercial tenants
- Grants should be used for building facades, streetscapes and improving ADA accessibility with eligibility for retail, office and commercial facilities in UA

Action Item: Conduct impact analysis for each project receiving incentives

Action Item: Create incentives policy and detailed program guidelines



Strategy: Formalize Office Business Retention & Expansion (BRE) Program

Action Item: Develop guidelines for Office BRE program and conduct annual visits

Action Item: Create an Existing Office Business Rapid Response Team

Action Item: Consider hosting an annual Existing Office Business Breakfast
