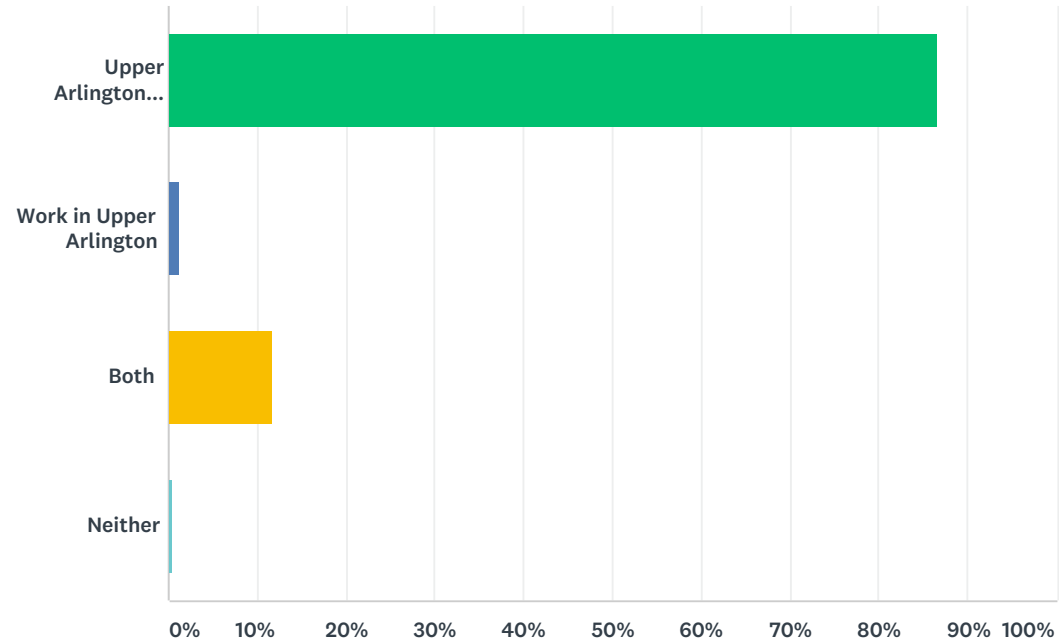

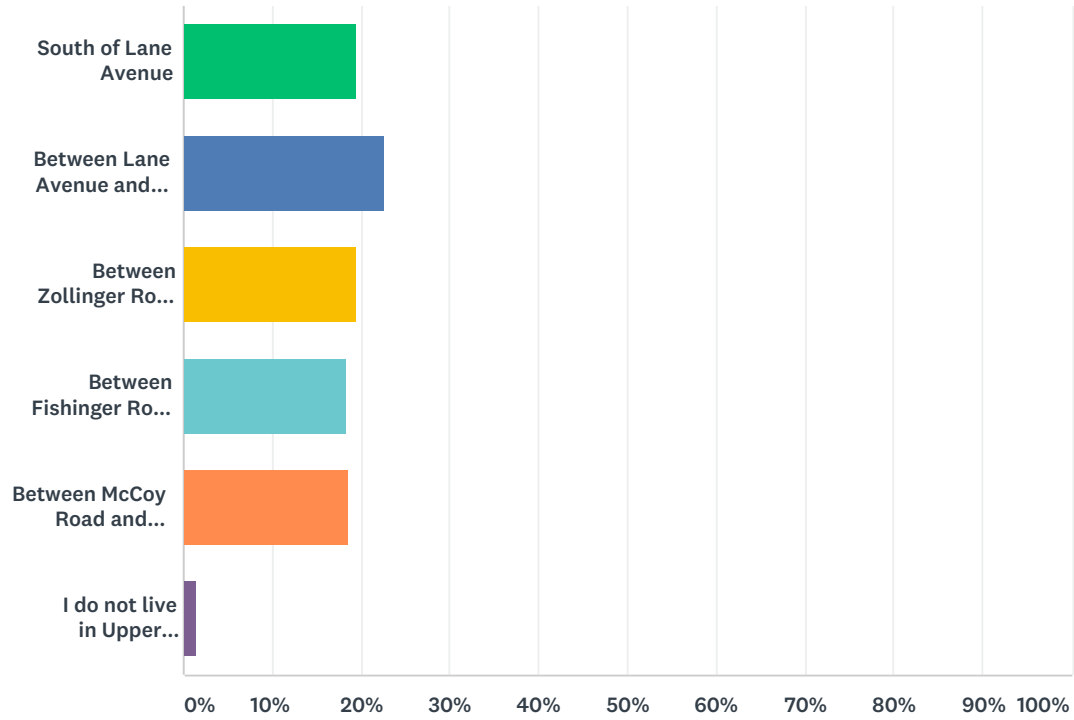

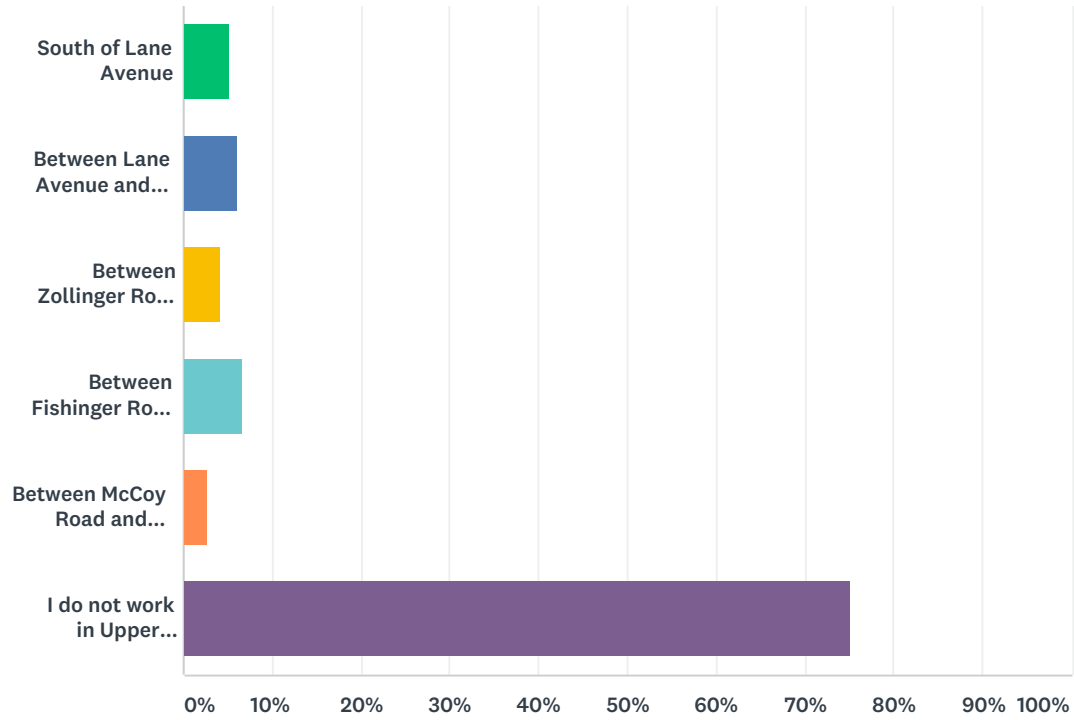

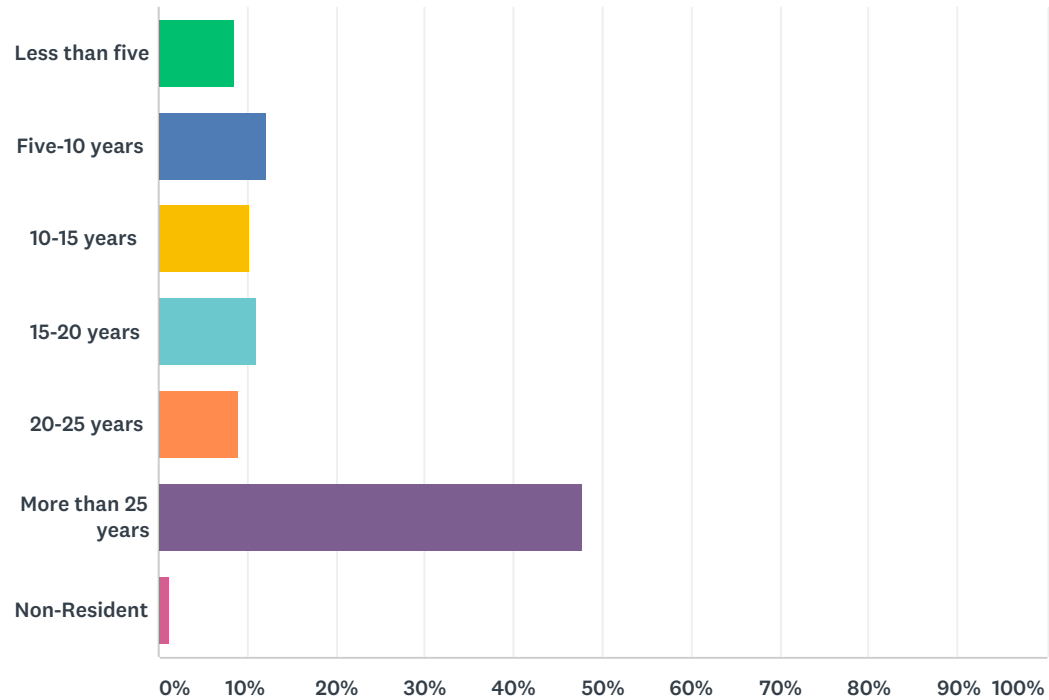

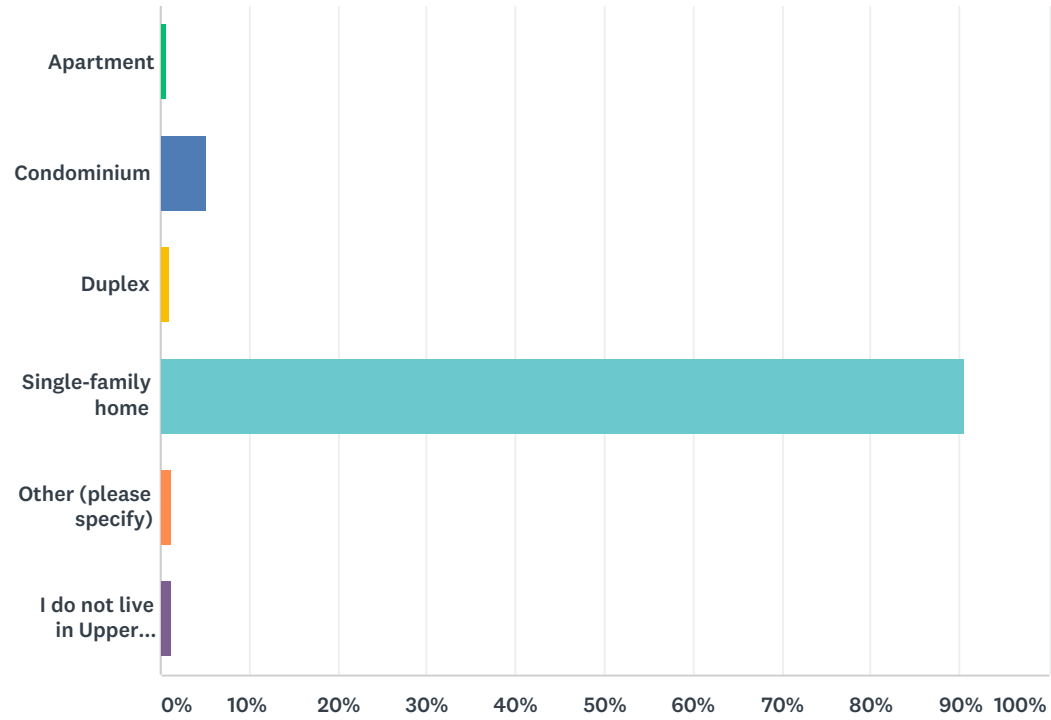

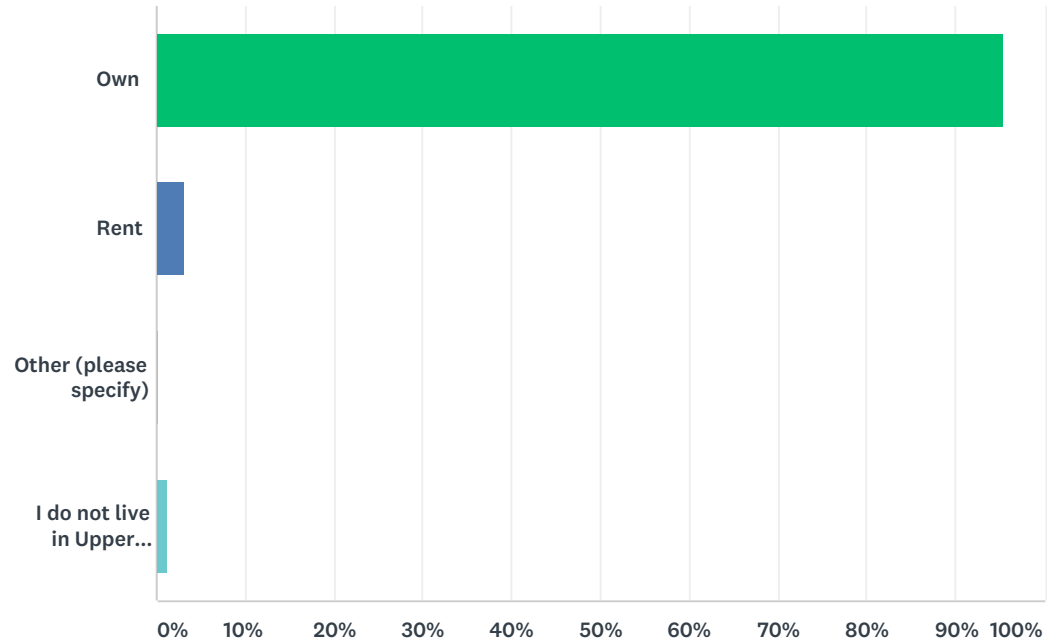

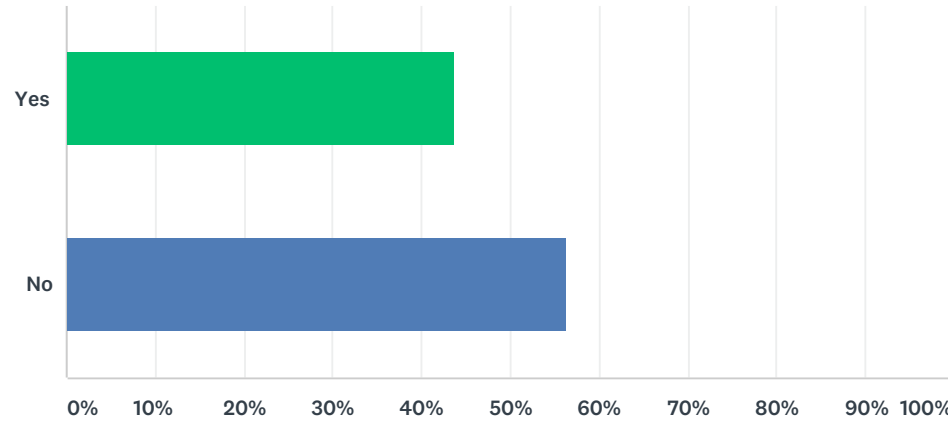

Q16 Are there children under the age of 18 in your home?

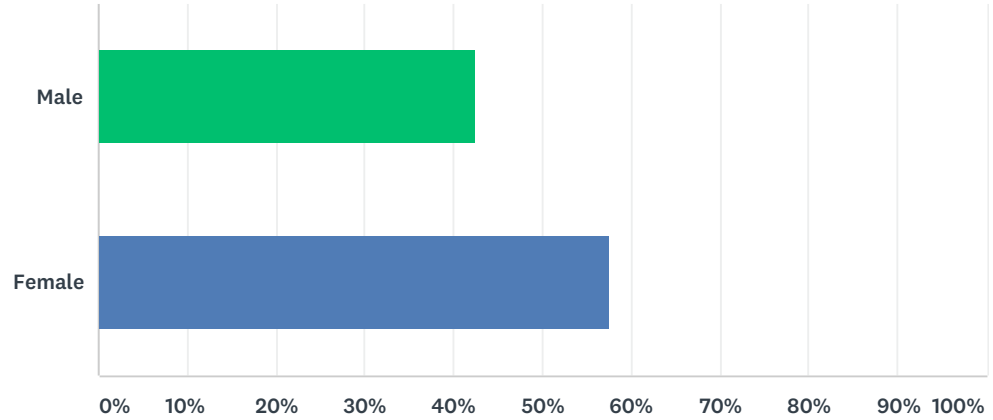

Q17 What is your gender?

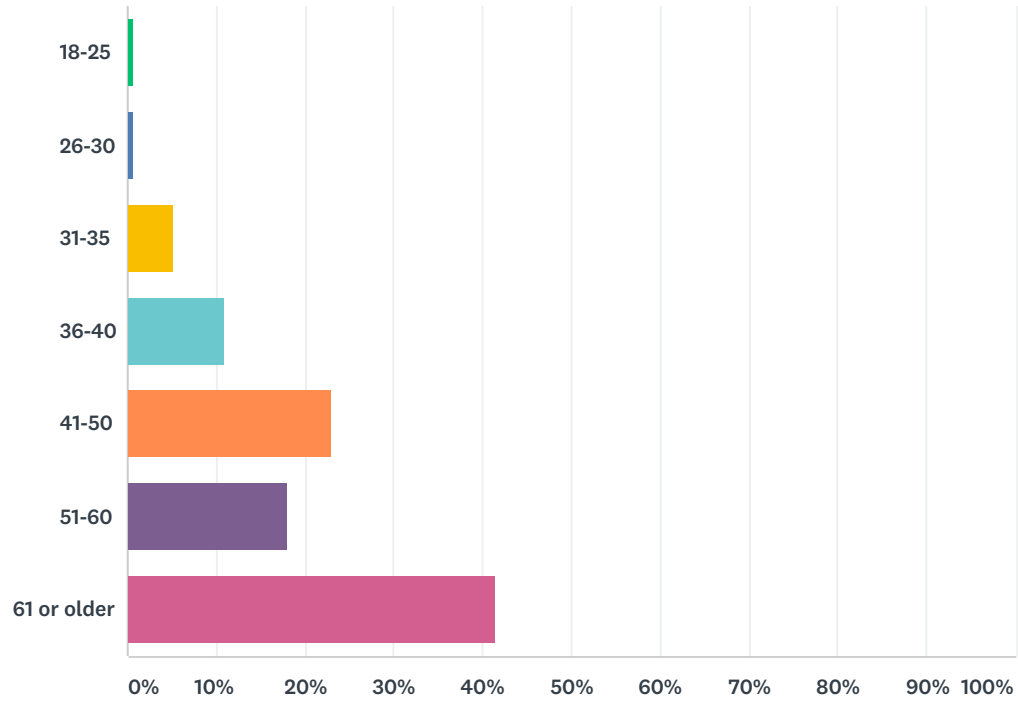

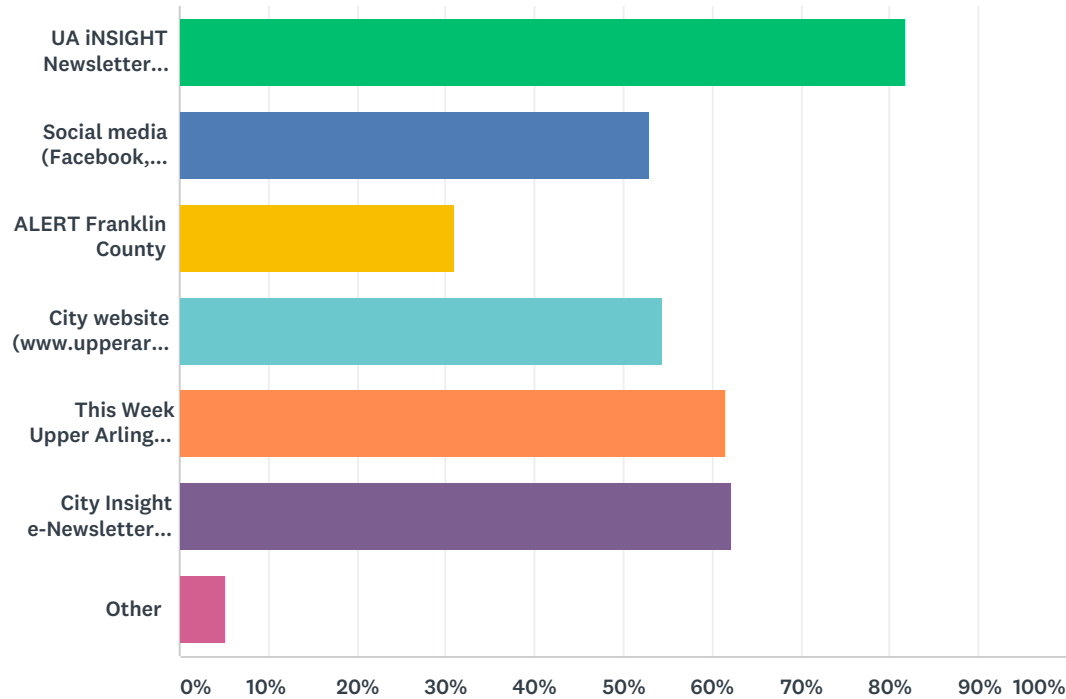

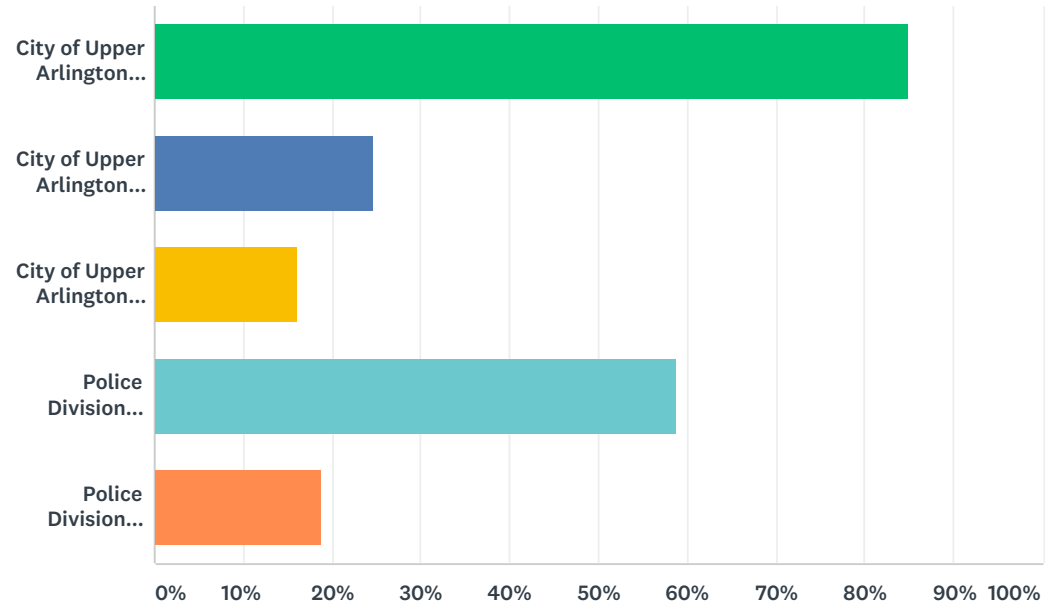
