McCoy Road Phase 2 Improvements Project
5-6:30 pm, Wednesday, December 15, 2021
Municipal Services Center, 3600 Tremont Road

McCoy Road serves as one of Upper Arlington's primary east/west connectors—reaching all the way to the Scioto River and with direct connections to Oxford Park, Thompson Park and St. Andrew's Church and School, with other community destinations such as Windermere Elementary School and Reed Road Park.

In 2021, as part of the City's Capital Improvement Program, the section of McCoy Road from Kenny Road to Woodbridge Road was improved with a new waterline, roadway resurfacing, dedicated parking along Thompson Park, curb bump-outs for safety enhancements, as well as spot curb and gutter repairs.

In 2022, improvements for Phase 2 will commence on McCoy Road from Woodbridge Road to Riverside Drive. Road resurfacing and spot curb and gutter repairs are planned as well as potential safety improvements:

- Intersection adjustments just east of Riverside drive at Masters Drive, McCoy Road and Lymington Road
- Oxford Park dedicated parking with a curb bump out

The anticipated timeline for construction to begin is summer, 2022 from Woodbridge Road to Riverside Drive. The cost estimate is \$1,000,000 for the roadway resurfacing. No additional waterline replacement work will take place.
